# 5.1 Nelson Tasman joint submission on the Government Policy Statement for Land Transport (2024)

Tasman District Council Community Policy Advisor, Neil Lindsay, presented the report, noting that the submission had been workshopped and that the draft submission had been circulated.

Nelson City Council Mayor N Smith requested that the minutes record that the draft submission had been circulated to Nelson City Councillors and that Councillors Sanson and Stallard had indicated that they were not supportive of the priority that was given to the Hope Bypass, however, that the members of the Joint Nelson Tasman Regional Transport Committee felt that the submission reflected the workshop feedback and were happy to proceed.

Discussion took place on the draft submission.

It was agreed to add the following points to the submission:

- Support for hypothecation of traffic infringement fee revenue to road safety activities
- Support for the Road to Zero 2030 target of a 40% reduction in road accident deaths and serious injuries but noting there were mixed views on the Road to Zero activity classification.

An additional clause 3 was added to delegate authority to the Chair to finalise the submission with the agreed additions.
